Welcome!


We are looking forward to having you join us at the Fringe Patio at the Tranzac Club. Below is some helpful information that will tell you what to expect when you come to the Patio.

Getting Here

The Fringe Patio is located at the Tranzac Club near the corner of Bloor Street West and Brunswick Avenue. The address is 292 Brunswick Avenue.





Bicycle

There are numerous bike racks outside of the venue. Please make sure you bring a lock to secure your bike. If you are using Bike Share, you can dock your bike at Dalton Rd / Bloor St W.



Bus

The closest accessible bus route is 94 Wellesley. Get off at Brunswick Avenue and make your way north on Brunswick Avenue. The Patio is approximately 350 metres from the bus stop at Harbord Street and Brunswick Avenue.



Streetcar

The closest accessible streetcar route is 510 Spadina. Get off at Spadina Station and make your way west on Bloor Street West, then turn left (south) onto Brunswick Avenue. The Patio is approximately 450 metres from the streetcar stop at Spadina Station.



Subway

Spadina Station is the closest subway station. To get to the Patio from here, make your way west on Bloor Street West, then turn left (south) onto Brunswick Avenue. The Patio is approximately 450 metres from Spadina Station.



Taxi

There will be enough room for taxis to make pickups and drop-offs right in front of the main entrance on Brunswick Avenue. Please let staff or a volunteer know if you need assistance calling a taxi.



Wheel-Trans

There will be enough room for Wheel-Trans for make pickups and drop-offs right in front of the main entrance on Brunswick Avenue.



Parking

Ample street parking is available on the east side of Brunswick Avenue. Parking is free for one hour between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM, and for three hours between 6:00 PM and 12:00 AM.

There is also street parking on the south side of Bloor Street West. Parking is \$5.25 per hour from Monday to Saturday between 8:00 AM and 9:00 PM and on Sundays between 1:00 PM and 9:00 PM. Parking is free for three hours from Monday to Saturday between 12:00 AM and 8:00 AM, Sundays between 12:00 AM and 1:00 PM, and all days between 9:00 PM and 12:00 AM.

A Green P surface parking lot is available at 365 Lippincott Street, one block west of the Patio. Parking is \$2.25 per 30 minutes up to a maximum of \$13.00 per day.

Arriving


This is what the Patio looks like if you are coming south on Brunswick Avenue from Bloor Street West.

Here is what the bar looks like.




Tranzac Club Washrooms

There are two gender neutral washrooms at the east end of the Tranzac Club. They do not have automatic door openers.

Here is what the washroom with three stalls looks like.




Here is what the washroom with one stall and three exposed urinals looks like.


Annex Hotel Washrooms
