

## CALL FOR INSTALLATIONS FRINGE PATIO 2018



The Toronto Fringe is accepting proposals from **visual/installation/durational artists** with ideas for **unique outdoor installations** to beautify the **Fringe Patio** and enhance the patron experience in the space, during the 2018 Toronto Fringe Festival (July 4-15).

The **Fringe Patio** is located in the **parking lot and hockey rink** of the Scadding Court Community Centre (707 Dundas Street West, at Dundas and Bathurst). It is Toronto's largest pop-up patio and sees thousands of visitors through the space. Programming includes free events, live music, local food vendors, and a licenced bar.

Installations will be installed by the artist(s) before the start of the festival (July 4), remain up throughout the festival, and taken down by the artist(s) after the Fringe Patio closes on the final day of the festival (July 15). Installations must be **weather proof**, and **secure** enough to remain in good condition for the full 12 days without harming or endangering patrons.

Artists are encouraged to **visit the site before applying**, in order to understand the demands of the space, and to propose ideas that incorporate elements that already exist (ie. the chain-link fence around the hockey rink, nearby trees, gates, concrete, etc.).

A small **honourarium** will be awarded to successful applicants.

**EXAMPLES OF INSTALLATIONS FOR INSPIRATION:** [hanging objects above walkways](#), chain-link fence art, installations that [patrons can contribute to and change](#) throughout the festival, temporary art on pavement/concrete/bricks, etc.
